Flying and crawling insect control

Flying and crawling insect control.

A pressurised handheld aerosol for use against flying insects such as flies, mosquitoes and other small flying insects by application as a space and surface spray. Can also be used against crawling insects such as ants, bedbugs, cockroaches, fleas. For indoor use only.

Directions for use:

For the control of flying insects, close all doors and windows and direct spray upwards into the centre of the room with a slow sweeping motion, 5-10 seconds in an average room (30 m²). Vacate room and keep door closed for 15 minutes.

Ventilate before re-entry.
For direct spray application, Spray from a distance of 15cm directly onto insect. Spray for 2 seconds for use against cockroaches and bedbugs. Spray for 1 second for use against fleas.

For residual spray application, Spray from a distance of 20 cm directly onto infected surfaces. Spray for 2 seconds for use against cockroaches. Spray for 1 second for use against bedbugs and fleas.
Repeat as necessary.

When stored in a cool dry place at temperature above 0°C and not exceeding 25°C
Envu Flying Insect Killer has a shelf life of 3 years.

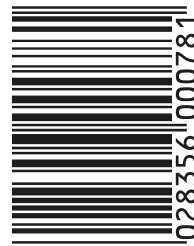
